Rules Objectives

- Safety
- Fairness
 - Rules are the same for everyone
- Used all over Europe
 - FS Rules generally define the competition
 - FSxx Competition Handbook defines competitions specific rules, procedures and deadlines

 - Released on 2023-10-09
- FSG Competition Handbook
 - Not yet released
- Other Important Documents

Rules Questions - Guidelines

Goal:

Clarify the wording, intent or interpretation of any specific rule.

- Wrong: Does this design fulfill the rules? / Does XYZ pass scrutineering?
- Correct: Does 2020 count as part of the 5 years in A 4.2.8
- Please check the FAQ
- Please check <u>all</u> the documents on the Rules & Important Documents page (<u>https://fsg.one/rules</u>)
- Please check the slides from the Academy
 - Your question may already have been answered!
- Full guidelines at <u>https://fsg.one/rt-guidelines</u>

Request for Comments – A 2.2.2

- A 2.2.2 To be classified as new, a vehicle must have at minimum, a newly manufactured chassis with significant changes in the primary structure to its predecessor.
- Rules team is currently debating a change for 2025
 - Keep "significant changes" but allow them also in other systems?


Things to consider

Major Changes for 2024

FSG 2024 is going to be EV-only





But CV is still in the Rules !?!

- FS-Rules Objective #3: Used all over Europe
- But: Not all competitions offer all classes/disciplines
 Defined in Competition Handbook
- CV chapter maintained by FS Austria
 - Same tools for Rules Questions and Feedback (see previous slides)
- Workshop on CV (Hybrid) by FS Austria on 2023-11-11

Major Changes for 2024

- Defined penalty handling for DC
- Added rule about shape of bodywork
- Increased requirements on EBS performance
- Pouch cell mounting
- Holes in TSAC
- Refined hand cart rules

Focus Topics



A 4.2.8 ("Five-Year-Rule")

- Multiple questions on this in 2023, wording was changed for 2024
- Intent: Limit participation in FS (teams) to 5 years
- "Participation" is when your team captain registers you at/after the TMD deadline
 - Whether or not you (or your team) are physically on site is irrelevant
 - If you are selected for a paid team member slot, we assume you were an active team member in that season
- You (and your team captain) are responsible to check this




Deadlines

Deadlines are enforced automatically by the server

- 13:00 means 13:00:00.000...
- Please don't wait until the last second to allow for unexpected issues (internet is down, file too big, slight difference in time/clock etc.)
- Additionally, A 5.4.2 gives a 24h grace period with penalties
- Exceptions may be granted in rare cases (e.g. due to problems on the competition side). Messaging the helpdesk <u>before</u> the deadline expires is essential.
- Contacting <u>helpdesk@formulastudent.de</u> is sufficient, no need to message half of the operative team directly



Competition Settings: No-DV / DCPI



- No need to submit ASF, ASRQ and DBC file (no further penalties for Late/Non-Submission)
- Some DV-specific rules do not have to be fulfilled (e.g. no ASMS needed)
- Irrevocable

Need to upload a DC-VSV

- No-DV can be set any time until waiting list closes (see Competition Handbook)
 - Existing penalties remain!




Changes will reflect increased demand for software-driven development processes.



Engineering Design Competition 101

How to improve your scoring and why the process has already started!

- During the season:
 - Documentation of design goals, processes, decisions, measurements, material tests, test drives...
 - Boost cross-functional knowledge among team members/ sub-teams
 - Challenge your concept and designs
- Preparation before competition:
 - EDR: 10 pages in total
 - Prepare your materials (folder, tablet, ...)
 - Practice your presentation skills
 - Review articles:
 - Best practices to excel in Engineering Design Event
 - Do's and Don'ts of Engineering Design Report

Overview

Plan your presentation:

Presentation schedule	~ 45 min
Installation/ preparation	~ 10 min
Presentation	10 min
Q&A session	5 min
Judge scoring	5 min
Feedback	5 min
De-installation	5 min

What to bring:

- Your laptop with the presentation slides (beamer or screen will be available)
- Optional (if you need it):
 - Speakers
 - devices for back-up material

Back-up material:

- Prepare yourself for the Q&A session with more details and information.
- **"please consider the environment before printing"** avoid tons of paper, prefer digital back-up or bring just one copy for all judges which you can re-use at the next competition.

The judges:

- You will be judged by 3-4 judges.
 - Pitch Video and presentation are scored by the same judges.
- The judging group is different for every team judges are changing rooms after every slot.

Finals:

- The teams with the best scorings in the presentations will present in the finals on the same day.
- Finalists are judged by the whole judging group.
- The order of the finalists' presentations is by car no.
- Just the 10 minutes presentation, no Q&A!

Context for your preparation

- Make sure to cover all perspectives of a typical business plan within your presentation, that is the core of the points
- Next to content a lot of the points can be well prepared with **practicing your presentation**
- The category *Novelty* was removed in last year's rule adaption

Business Plan Presentation (BPP)

What's new?

Refinement of the rules

- Clarification of the Business Plan Presentation Objective (S 1.1.1)
 - "... the business model must relate to the team's specific prototype vehicle or a specific component of it ..."
 - "In doing so, the business must offer the vehicle or component as a product, or sell a service **based on it** ..."
- 2. Reduction of penalty points (S 1.4.2)
 - "If the business model presented does not relate to one of the areas listed within S 1.1.1, **15 penalty points** will be deducted from the team's BPP scoring"

Context for the rule S 1.1.1

- Your business plan needs to be based on your specific vehicle
- Consider what parts or the entire
 vehicle can create a rewarding
 business opportunity



Cost and Manufacturing Event Important FAQ

- Supporting Material File
 - Technical Drawings, Exploded views and/or pictures
 - Should help to get to know your vehicle and how it is/can be manufactured
 - We don't want to make more rules for more giving more regulations
 - Not for the Real case
- Splitting Electrical System => Not considered yet



Cost and Manufacturing Event

Hints and Tips for the Event

Start with a general introduction at the event



- Prepare examples for each topic in the rules regarding
 Cost Understanding (e.g. Posters, calculations, Presentations)
- Know your documents (if your need more time for searching your documents the judges will deduced points) – it should be a plus when you are fast (not negative due to the fact that they have more chances to find mistakes)
- Have min. 2 versions available (electronic, printed, its up to you)
- Involve your design engineers in the manufacturing process
- It is a team event!
